

Manila Business College: Study Program for Foreign Students

Diploma: Undergraduate Degree

Courses Offered:

- Bachelor of Accountancy
- Bachelor of Science in Business Administration (BSBA) Major in:
 - Marketing
 - Management

 - Banking & Finance

Eligibility:

- High School Graduate
- Graduate of any Vocational Course
- Middle School Graduate

Program Duration

A. For Regular Foreign Applicants:

- High School Graduate
 - 3 years equal to 9 terms (162 units)
- Graduate of any Vocational Course
 - 1 year to 1 ½ year (depending on the vocational course)
 - Must acquire at least 54 to 72 units
- Middle School Graduate
 - 4 years equal to 12 terms (162 units)
 - Plus additional English Special Course

Tuition Fee: \$ 1,200 (USD) per term

Food/Dormitory: \$ 800 (USD) per term or (\$200/month)

B. For Fast Track Degree Program (FTDP) Applicants:

- Open only for Graduates of High School and any Vocational Course
 - Special Curriculum (Tutorial – Style Professor)
 - 2 Weeks duration for every term (Monday to Saturday)
 - 18 units (or 6 course subjects) are compressed into 2 weeks
 - After the 2 weeks study period, the student can return to his country
 - The requirements (i.e. research papers, assignments, and projects) are submitted to the professor via the internet (Distance learning)
 - Must return to Manila thrice a year to acquire 54 units (or 18 course subjects) per year
 - For HS Graduates: 3 years to earn a degree
 - For Vocational Course Graduates: 1-1 ½ year to earn a degree (depending on the vocational course)

Tuition Fee: \$ 400 (USD) per term

Food/Dormitory: \$ 300 (USD) per term

Fast Track Degree Program (FTDP) only accepts group applications:

- 40 Students per class
- At least 3 to 5 classes per term
- Accepts group application every 2 weeks

Program Highlights:

1. Train in business education that combines Asian and Western concepts of management with Chinese business culture and economic studies.
2. Study and practice English Communication.
